Open items for discussion:

Speed bumps on Oakwood Hills Dr:

General feeling is, while speeding continues to be an issue, the speed bumps referendum not likely to be approved by enough residents to pass. Suggestion to look in to other possible signs or speed abatement methods.

Pot hole at intersection of Overbend Trail & Oakwood Hills Rd:

Suggest that after the Spring thaw, residents need to call individually to the county to make our voices heard to have repairs done.

Entrance lights need attention:

Volunteers will look at feasibility of upgrading during next Work Day.

Airport:

Possible impact to neighborhood if Lawrenceville's Briscoe Field is allowed to expand to commercial jets.
